OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME:

3. वृत्तपत्रे आणि पत्रकारांच्या बाजूने सार्वजनिक उच्च मानकांची देखभाल करणे आणि नागरिकत्वाचे हक्क आणि जबाबदाऱ्या या दोन्ही गोष्टींची जाणीव करून देणे.
4. पत्रकारितेच्या व्यवसायात गुंतलेल्या सर्वांमध्ये जबाबदारीची भावना आणि सार्वजनिक सेवेच्या वाढीस प्रोत्साहित करणे.
5. सार्वजनिक हिताच्या आणि महत्त्वच्या बातम्यांचा पुरवठा आणि प्रसार प्रतिबंधित करण्याच्या संभाव्य विकासाचे पुनरावलोकन करणे.

INTRODUCTION OF PROGRAMME:

महाराष्ट्रात ६ जानेवारी हा दिवशी मराठी पत्रकार दिन म्हणून साजरा केला जातो. ६ जानेवारी १८१२ बाळशास्त्री गंगाधरशास्त्री जांभेकर यांचा जन्म दिवस आहे. जांभेकर यांनी ६ जानेवारी १८३२ रोजी 'दर्पण' हे मराठीतले पहिले वृत्तपत्र त्यांनी सुरू केले. या काळामध्ये बाळशास्त्रींनी अनेक महत्वाचे निर्णय घेतले शिक्षणाच्या संदर्भामध्ये मोलाची भूमिका बजावली बाळशास्त्री जांभेकरांचा जन्मदिवस हा महाराष्ट्र सरकारतर्फे 'दर्पण दिन' अथवा 'वृत्तपत्र दिन' म्हणून साजरा होतो.

पत्रकार हा समाजाचा आरसा असतो, जो प्रतिकूल परिस्थितीतही सत्य प्रकट करत असतो. पत्रकारितेला लोकशाहीचा चौथा स्तंभ म्हणून ओळख आहे. पण, आज २१ व्या शतकात या चौथ्या स्तंभाचा विचार केला असता, 'माध्यमे खरंच आपली जबाबदारी पार पाडत आहेत का?' हा मोठा प्रश्न आपल्यासमोर 'आ' वासून उभा ठाकला आहे. त्यासाठी सर्वप्रथम माध्यमांनी अधिकारांच्या किंवा सत्तेच्या दुरुपयोगाला थांबवण्याची गरज आहे. मात्र, सध्या माध्यमांचाच वापर एक सत्ताकेंद्र किंवा अधिकार केंद्र म्हणून सर्रास केला जातो. कोणत्याही देशांत लोकशाही तेव्हाच बळकट होते, जेव्हा तिथली माध्यमे स्वतंत्र आणि निष्पक्ष असतात. काही निष्पक्ष माध्यमे प्रथेप्रमाणे आपल्या देशातही आहेत. परंतु, पूर्वग्रहदूषितता आणि पक्षपातीपणानेही त्यांना ग्रासले आहेच. लोकशाहीमध्ये सर्वात जबाबदार असा हा माध्यमांचा चौथा स्तंभ. त्याचे कारण म्हणजे माध्यमांचा जनतेशी येणारा दैनंदिन संबंध. पण, एवढा सशक्त असलेला हा चौथा स्तंभ सध्या कमकुवत झालेला दिसतो. म्हणूनच आजच्या माध्यमांनी आरशात पाहण्याची, आत्मपरीक्षण करण्याची नितांत गरज आहे.

प्रिंट आणि इलेक्ट्रॉनिक मीडिया सोबतच सध्या सोशल मीडियाचा वापर मोठ्या प्रमाणात होऊ लागला आहे. जगभर आयटी क्षेत्रातील साक्षरतेचे प्रमाण वाढत चालल्याने ऑनलाईन पत्रकारितेचे क्षेत्र अधिकाधिक व्यापक होणार आहे. भारतीय पत्रकारितेला पत्रकारांच्या अनेक पिढ्यांनी समृद्ध वारसा दिला आहे. काही मीडिया हाऊस आणि पत्रकार आपले काम खूप चांगल्या प्रकारे काम करत आहे. पण सर्वांनी मिळून चांगली पत्रकारिता केली तर लोकशाहीच्या चौथा स्तंभाला खरी आणि योग्य ओळख प्राप्त होईल.

National Voter's Day (25 January 2022)


