

Expressing his views in his speech, he said, "This day is celebrated to honour the contribution of Maulana Abul Kalam, India's first Union Minister of Education. National Education Day is celebrated on November 11 to mark the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Education Minister of Independent India. This day is celebrated in honor of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad's contribution in the field of Indian education. National Education Day has been

celebrated on November 11 every year since 2008. Maulana Abul Kalam Azad was the first Union Education Minister of the country after Independence. National Education Day is celebrated in the country on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Abul Kalam Azad. Kalam served as the Education Minister of Independent India from 1947 to 1958. Maulana Abul Kalam Azad has also made significant contribution in the Indian War of Independence. He worked as an educator, journalist, freedom fighter and politician. Abul Kalam Azad played an important role in improving the educational structure of India. Abul Kalam Azad used to say that our dreams turn into thoughts and the results of thoughts come into action. Kalam dreamed of improving the educational situation in the country and worked hard to achieve it. Considering the contribution of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad in the field of education, the then Ministry of Manpower Development decided to celebrate this day as National Education Day. The ministry had said that his birthday would be celebrated on November 11 every year as National Education Day to commemorate the contribution made by this great son of India for education in India. "Educators need to inculcate in students a keen sense of perseverance, creativity, entrepreneurship and ethical leadership and make them role models," he said. Maulana Abul Kalam Azad had said that empowerment of women was a necessary and important for the betterment of the nation. Kalam also founded the Board of Rural Higher Education, the National Organization for Basic Education and other institutions. 




