

celebrated on November 11 every year since 2008. Maulana Abul Kalam Azad was the first Union Education Minister of the country after Independence. National Education Day is celebrated in the country on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Abul Kalam Azad. Kalam served as the Education Minister of Independent India from 1947 to 1958. Maulana Abul Kalam Azad has also made significant contribution in the Indian War of Independence. He worked as an educator, journalist, freedom fighter and politician. Abul Kalam Azad played an important role in improving the educational structure of India. Abul Kalam Azad used to say that our dreams turn into thoughts and the results of thoughts come into action. Kalam dreamed of improving the educational situation in the country and worked hard to achieve it. Considering the contribution of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad in the field of education, the then Ministry of Manpower Development decided to celebrate this day as National Education Day. The ministry had said that his birthday would be celebrated on November 11 every year as National Education Day to commemorate the contribution made by this great son of India for education in India.
