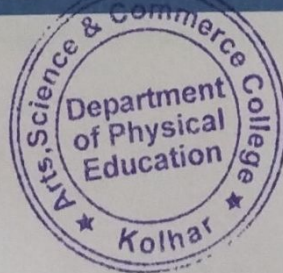



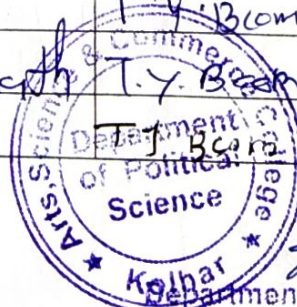

### **Details of the Programme:**

In the Introduction Mr. P.S. Auti said that the Human Rights are those minimal rights which every individual must have against the State or other public authority by virtue of his being a 'member of the human family', irrespective of any other consideration. The concept of human rights is as old as the ancient doctrine of 'natural rights' founded on natural law, the expression 'human rights' is of recent origin, emerging from (post-Second World War) international Charters and Conventions. The International Human Rights Day is celebrated in the World on 10<sup>th</sup> December with the aim of to create awareness about Human Rights among the students and stakeholders.

The Chief Guest of the Programme Dr. H. R. Aher, Principal of Arts, Science and Commerce College, Kolhar, delivered lecture on topic – "Fundamental Rights of Indian Constitution".

He said that the Human Rights are Universal; every man has Human Rights from born. Without Human Rights man could not develop its Life. Indian constitutional Assembly includes Human Rights in Indian constitution as a Fundamental Rights of Indian citizen The UNO has declared the Human Rights Declaration on 10th December, 1948 to remembering this day International Human Rights Day is celebrated in the World. He said in speech that every other human on this planet, irrespective of their caste, religion, creed, gender, nationality, social status or color are entitled to these rights. These rights are being protected by respective country constitution. The Constitution of independent India came



into force on 26th January. The impact of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights on drafting part III of the Constitution is apparent. The constitution of Indian was adopted to constitute the country as an independent, communist, secular, autonomous and republic to secure the Indian citizens by the justice, equality, liberty and union. When the constitution of India was adopted, the citizens of India gets Fundamental rights, Liberty of judiciary, travel, live, speech, religion, education etc. India has acceded to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights as well as to the subsequent International Covenants of Economic, Social and Cultural rights and Civil & Political Rights adopted by the Central Assembly of the United Nations. Fundamental Rights enshrined in Part III of the Constitution have emerged from the doctrine of natural rights. Fundamental Rights are the modern name for what have been traditionally known as Natural Rights. The Natural Rights transformed into fundamental rights operate as a constitutional limitation or a restriction on the powers of the organs set up by the Constitution or the State action. Judicial Review, Enforcement became an inseparable concomitant of fundamental rights. As no right of freedom can be absolute, limitations have been imposed to each fundamental right in the interest of securing social justice. Enforcement of fundamental rights can even be suspended or prevented in emergency. Directive Principles enshrined in Part IV of the Constitution epitomize the ideals, aspirations the sentiments, the precepts and the goals of our entire freedom movement. The wisdom of the forefathers of the Constitution was justified in incorporating non-judiciable human rights in the concrete shape of the directive principles.

On this occasion, students Miss. Vashnavi Dokhe and Mr. Manvar Shaikh gave speech on Human Rights and Indian Constitution. 

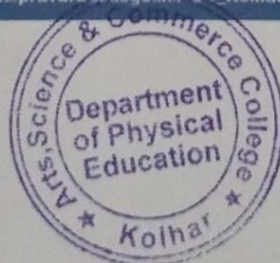
