II. Title of best practice: Eco-friendly Ganapati Festival and Immersion

Introduction:

Ganesh festival is celebrated every year in a traditional way creating spiritual awareness among people. Ganesh festival is one of the biggest festivals in India with celebrations in large cities and villages. The festival is spread over 11 days. At the end of the festival, Ganesh idols are immersed into the water bodies. The festival also generates a large amount of holy waste (Nirmalya) in the form of flowers, decoration material and other religious offerings. In all, Worship and Immersion of Ganesh idols through household and community celebrations cause pollution of water bodies. The rivers, ponds, streams, wells etc. which are already polluted, get further polluted with holy waste, including pieces of idols which have not got dissolved, flowers, and decoration material etc.

However, after the celebration of Ganesh Chaturthi and immersion of the idols; the ponds, rivers and lakes are often left dirty and polluted, harming all water creatures and mother earth.

These are some of the ways by which the celebrations, immersions and rituals are causing harm to the environment:

- a. Contribute to water pollution due to immersion of idol and organic waste
- b. Contribute to soil pollution by dumping thermocol decoration
- c. The broken idols float on water affects sanctity of the festival
- d. Non-degradable idols and material are blocking the natural flow of water and causing stagnation

Such pollution causes damage to eco system. To avoid causing harm to the environment, it must be celebrated with the spirit of ecological sustainment and protection.

Goals:

- Awareness about environment conservation among Villagers
- Express our gracefulness to Lord Ganesh
- To reduce water pollution
- Use of flowers and leaves as the fertilizers

The Context:

Ganapati festival is one of the most important festivals celebrated among the youth of Maharashtra. At present idols of Ganapati are made of by using plaster of paris, cement, plastic papers containing toxic chemicals. After ten days, these idols of Ganapati are immersed into the river and well water. These idols made of plaster of paris and other non-dissolvable materials are very harmful for environment and increase the water pollution. The villagers use this polluted and chemically affected water for drinking purpose which is harmful for the health of people.

The Practice:

By considering the above context, the college has initiated a movement against the wrong tradition of making of Ganapati idols and its immersion into the usable water sources. College staff and NSS volunteers actively participate in this work. We make groups of students along with faculty for the purpose. On the first day of Ganapati Festival, we appeal to buy the Ganapati Idol made of clay instead of POP. We also create awareness among people during cultural festival organized through '**EK GAON EK GANPATI**'. On the day of immersion of Ganapati, these groups of students and faculty go to the bank of Pravara River, where people gather to immerse the idols. We appeal and request them not to immerse the idols made of plaster of paris and other harmful materials. These groups collect the idols made of plaster of paris and righteously put in the ground. We also collect the idols immersed into the water. The used flowers and leaves are collected in a basket and used for making bio fertilizers for the trees in the campus.

Evidence of Success:

- People started using the idol made of dissolvable clay.
- Besides, it is matter of religious belief; people allow to handover the idols to our groups instead of immersing into the water.
- Water pollution of the river due to idols and holy waste is reduced.
- We succeeded to create environment awareness among the villagers

Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

- Most of the people refuse to handover the idols considering it as against religion.
- People prefer to buy idols made of plaster of paris, since they are cheaper than clay idols.

Theme of the Programme: 'Workshop on 'Making of Eco-friendly Ganpati Idols'

Objectives of the Programme:

1. To revive the age-old tradition of worshiping Ganesha Idol made of natural clay and create a healthy and safe environment.
2. To spread awareness & encourage students to use eco-friendly Ganpati.

Introduction of Programme:

Ganesh Chaturthi, also called Vinayaka Chavithi, is an auspicious festival which is celebrated for 10 days every year. The festival is celebrated in the mid-August to September. It marks the birthday of the beloved Lord Ganesha. The excitement of Ganesh Chaturthi settles in weeks before the festival actually begins. Sculptor Artists start preparing idols of Ganesha in different poses and sizes. The Ganesha idols are installed in beautifully decorated 'pandal' at homes, temples or localities. The 10th day is farewell to Ganesha known as Ganpati Visarjan, a ceremony wherein the statue is now immersed in water.

Most of the idols used by devotees are prepared from plaster of paris. PoP contains calcium sulphate hemihydrate, which takes years to fully dissolve in water, thus causing water pollution. It reduces oxygen levels in the water, killing the fish and other aquatic life.

In this context, a eco-friendly Ganpati idol-making workshop was organised by NSS of our institute for the students to promote eco-friendly Ganpati idols and motivate children to create their own idols for the upcoming festival.

Details of the Programme:

Department of NSS had organized a one day workshop on “**Making of Eco-friendly Ganpati Idols**” on 2nd September, 2021.

The resource person for the workshop was **Hon. Mr. Raju Dalavi**, well known Sculptor Artist, Kolhar. Dr. S. N. Shingote (Principal), Dr. P.T. Tupe (NSS, Programme officer), Mr. P.B. Vikhe (IQAC Coordinator) were present for the workshop.

The workshop was commenced with the Inaugural session where **Hon. Dr. S. N. Shingote** (Principal, Arts, Science and Commerce College, Kolhar) delivered the welcome note and introduced the gathering with the vision and mission of the college. On this occasion he focused on need of eco-friendly celebration of the festivals to protect our environment.

Mr. Raju Dalavi (Sculptor Artist) graced the gathering on materials required and easy ways to prepare clay idols of Ganpati.

Mr. P.T. Tupe told that it is our responsibility to make use of eco-friendly festivals in a larger way so that there will be a pollution free atmosphere everywhere and we can celebrate it without any harm to our environment.

In the second session the resource person **Mr. Raju Dalavi** imparted skills to the participating students and guided them about the shape of Ganesha, fingers, and idol completion. **Mr. P.B. Vikhe**, IQAC Coordinator proposed the vote of thanks.

The workshop witnessed the participation of students from all streams with full zeal and enthusiasm. After the workshop, an interactive session was also conducted in which students asked various questions to the resource person to which the resource person responded very clearly and satisfied the curiosity of the students.
