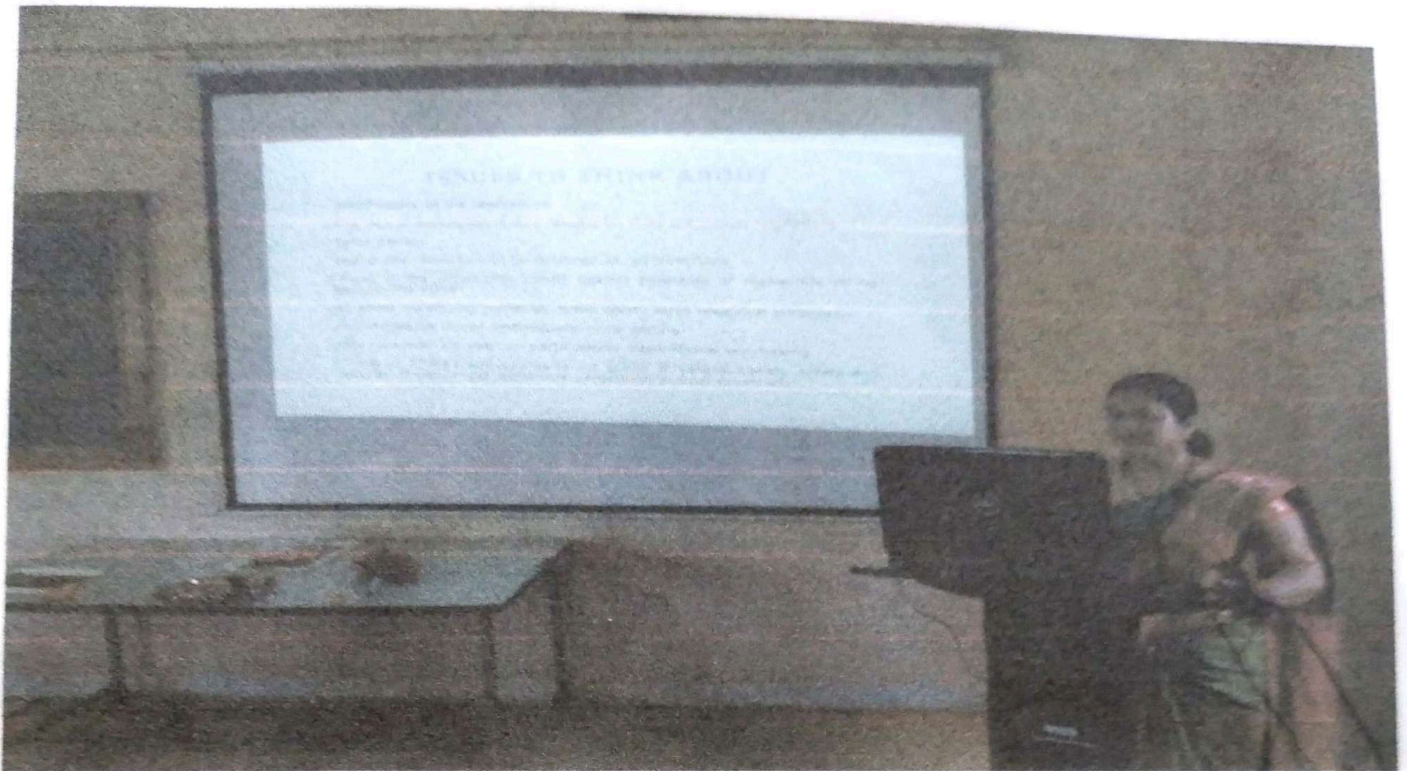
Workshop on INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS: ISSUES AND CONCERNS

She guided on legislative framework for securing IPR. She also expressed her views on various issues and recommendations related to IPR.

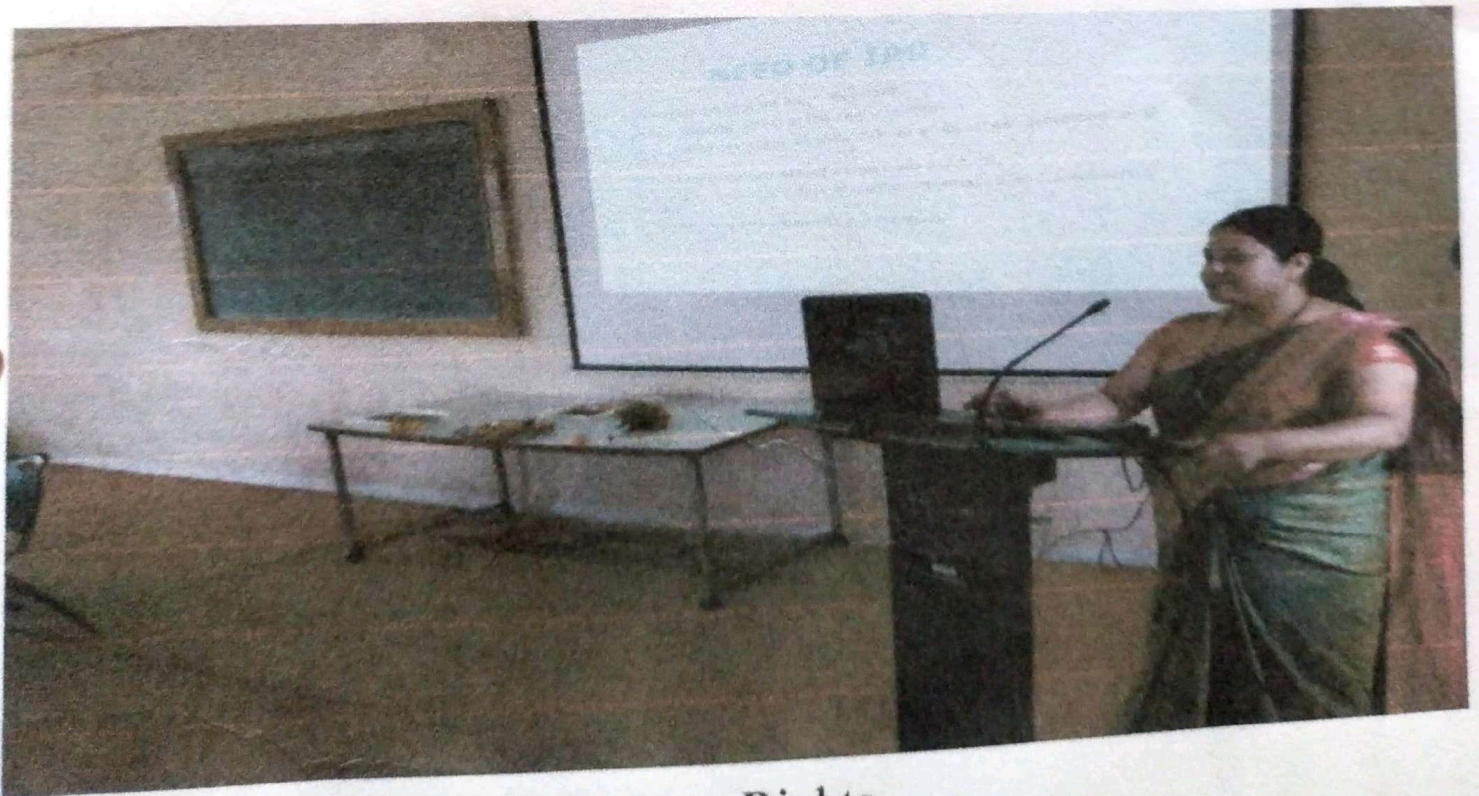

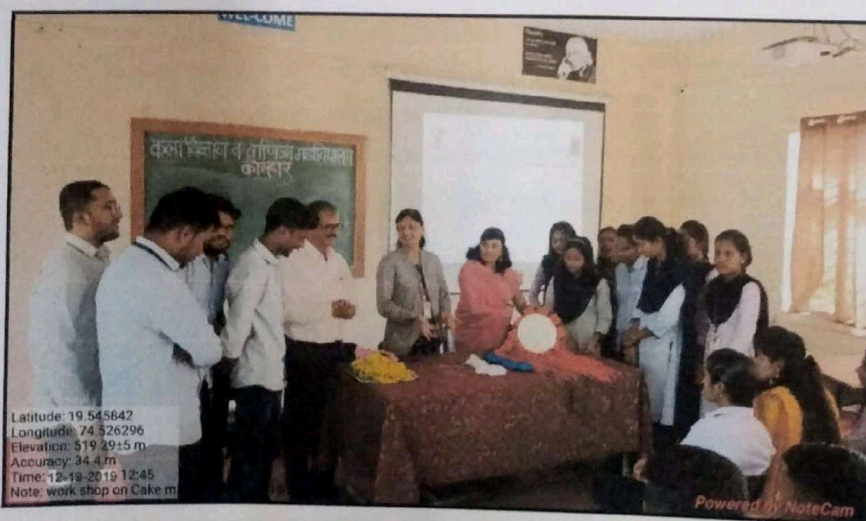
