Details of the Programme:



Details of the Programme:

National Nutrition Month - September 2021

Arts, Science and Commerce College, Kolhar, organised National Nutrition Month- September 2021 program in collaboration with ten Anganwadis of Bhagwatipur under National Service Scheme and Integrated Child Development. The said program was conducted following the guidelines of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune and the instructions given by the Government of Maharashtra. Sarpanch of Bhagwatipur, Mr. Dattatraya Rajbhoj, Deputy Sarpanch, Mr. Prakash Kharde and Gram Panchayat members were also present. Chief Guest, Dr. Jayashri Singar guided the audience on the topic of 'Women's Nutrition and Health'. In her lecture, she elaborated on the importance of fruits, leafy vegetables and dry-fruits. She advised to eat pulses and vegetable platters of different flavours for breakfast. *Palak* is rich in fiber, vitamins and minerals that improve blood and eye health. The iron folic acid in flax seeds improves bone health. It improves health along with taste. Capsicum is very effective in boosting immunity and vitamin C is found in citrus fruits in large amounts like oranges, lemons, guava and most importantly amla. Papaya is also high in vitamin C and fiber so it is healthy to consume. Also, dry fruits like almonds, cashews, pistachios, raisins, figs, apricots, etc. are essential for our health. Along with that, the diet of pregnant women and lactating mothers should include milk, curd, buttermilk, eggs and butter. Consuming one spoon of Gavran ghee daily is essential for women of all ages.

Chief guest was College Principal, Dr. Sopanrao Shingote who expressed his views. He requested women to take care of their own health along with their families. He advised women to cook nutritious food as well as to consume it. He explained that since men and women are two wheels of the same car, their diet and exercise should be appropriate and complementary. On this occasion, an exhibition of nutritious food was prepared by ten Anganwadis in Bhagwatipur and was artistically presented. In this, various types of nutritious recipes included parathas made of fenugreek leaves, pulses, idli, dosa, uttappa, dhokla made from rice and udit dal, thalipeeth, dhirde, etc. Also, a beautiful and attractive rangoli was drawn of broken pulses, leafy vegetables, fruits and tubers. On this occasion, medicinal plants were distributed under National Service Scheme in College of Arts and Commerce, Kolhar. Medicinal plant Gulvel prepared in Botany department of the college was distributed to Hon'ble Sarpanch, Upasarpanch, Gram Panchayat members and Talathi, Agriculture Officer, Health Officer. 



