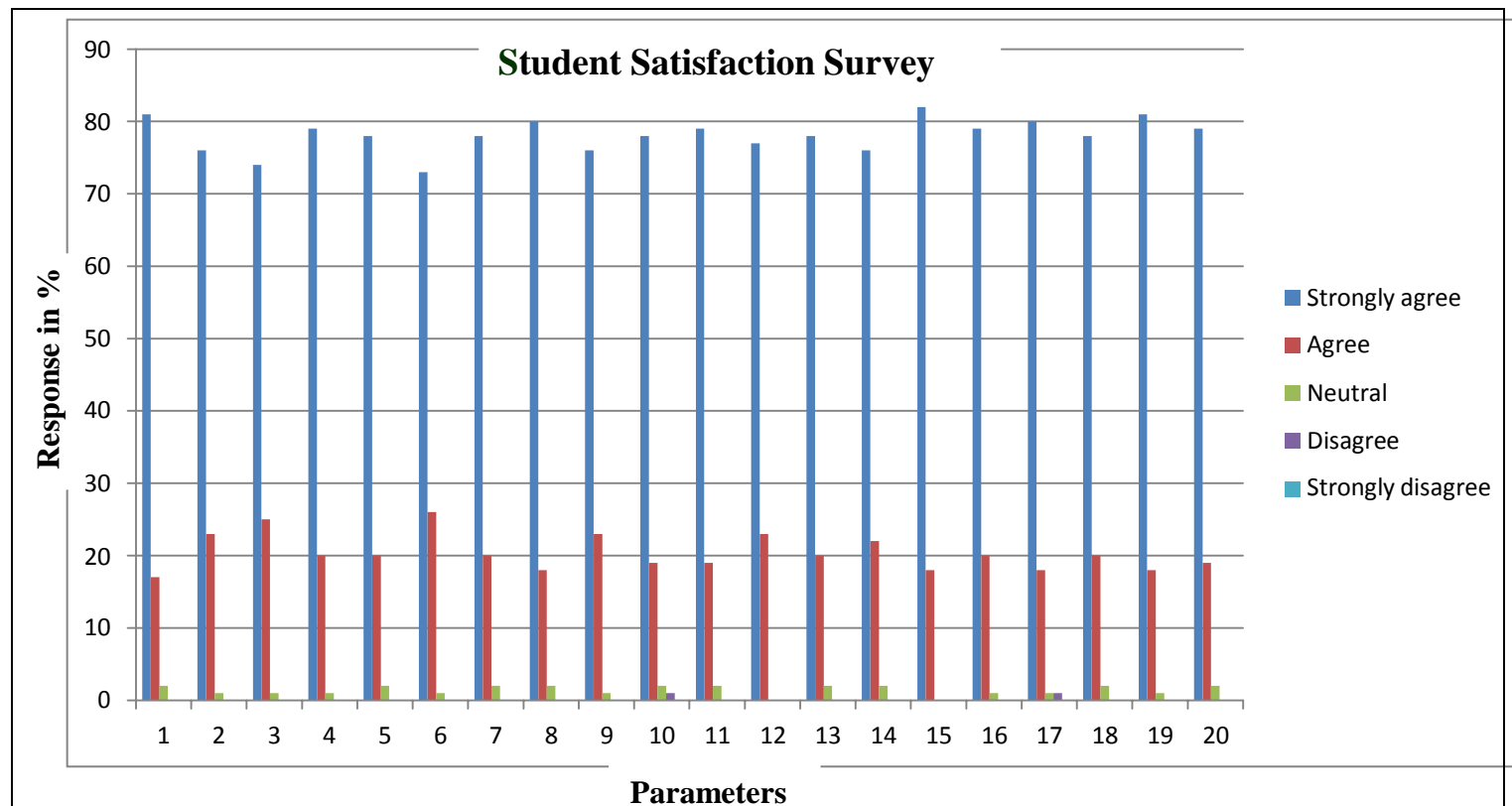
### **Student Satisfaction Survey on Teaching Learning and Evaluation Process**
